## Save Our Square Update April 5, 2018



#### To Historic Square Building Owners,

MORE GOOD NEWS – Iowa's Downtown Revitalization Grant Managers came to Centerville on April 3, 2018 to train and advise our Save Our Square Team

The SOS Team spent 3 hours with the experts learning about what is needed to have a successful grant application. We learned about two key elements: 1) the community MUST demonstrate

strong support for the SOS project (meaning letters of support and donations to the project) and 2) both the community and the building owners MUST show evidence of project readiness (clear description of intended modifications of each building and project funding in place when then application is submitted).

Our next step is to complete the required building surveys. The building surveys are scheduled for the week of May 14<sup>th</sup>. Receipt of the \$150 fee for each building you want surveyed will secure you a spot in the building survey plan. Remember a completed building survey DOES NOT guarantee that you will receive grant funding. The lowa DTR grant team looks at each building and gives it a rating based on need, district impact, and owner readiness. The SOS Team is dedicated to helping each committed building owner submit the best application possible.

In May, the SOS Team will be meeting with a highly successful DTR grant writer to learn everything we can about the technical aspects of telling our story. We will also be exploring various lending opportunities for building owners to finance required match funding.
