At 9:20 A.M. Smith moved to open the public hearing on Tax Sale #2003-7238. Seconded by Demry. All voted aye. Waits read the legal description, recording fees, publication costs, and current taxes. John Hatfield made the opening bid of \$5.00. There were no other bids. Demry moved to close the public hearing. Seconded by Smith. All voted aye. Demry moved to accept the \$5 bid. Seconded by Smith. All voted aye.

At 9:25 A.M. Smith moved to open the public hearing on Tax Sale #2010-10469. Seconded by Demry. All voted aye. Waits read the legal description, recording fees, publication costs, and current taxes. John Hatfield withdrew his bid but agreed to pay the publishing costs. There were no other bids. Demry moved to close the public hearing. Seconded by Smith. All voted aye. Larry Golic and Tom Zaputil addressed the board regarding the conditions of the roads. Golic stated there are signs down, a hole in the road with no flag, the roads are too wide, and the rock is too big with no fines in it to keep it on the road. Zaputil stated the hard surface near him is 24' wide while the gravel road is 30' wide. The roads keep creeping out because the rock rolls off and won't go down due to lack of lime. Golic asked why Class A rock isn't being used and if they are willing to look into it. County Engineer, Matt Haden, stated he would look into it. Haden also stated ¾" rock doesn't last, they are using the bigger rock to try to build the base. Secondary Roads is working with less manpower, a tighter budget and higher costs but they are trying to narrow the roads. Golic advised the board to hire a firm to find a qualified engineer. The Board isn't qualified to know what to look for. He also advised to reuse culverts instead of buying new.

Haden stated a labor position has been advertised and he is accepting applications until May 24th. He hopes to have a hire letter for approval at the June 5th meeting. There was a complaint about a road being closed south of Exline but it was due to Putnam County. The crews continue to work getting mowing done before Memorial Day and culvert replacement.

Diane Buss, CDS Coordinator, stated this is mental health month and provided the board with a presentation on the strides Appanoose County has taken in mental health over the last few years. She also spoke about articles that will be appearing in the National Association of Counties and the lowegian. She concluded by giving the board her resignation letter effective June 30, 2017.
