

July 17, 2017

Appanoose County Board of Supervisors met in regular session July 17, 2017 at 9:00 A.M. in the Boardroom of the Courthouse. Present: Mark Waits, Chairman and Linda Demry, Boardmember.

Absent: Neal Smith.

Demry moved to table Central Iowa Tourism funding request, move Robert Ritter to the top, and approve the agenda. Seconded by Waits. All voted aye.

Demry moved to approve the minutes of the July 3, 2017 meeting. Seconded by Waits. All voted aye.

Robert Ritter presented pictures of 195<sup>th</sup> Avenue. He stated the ditch was full and nothing has changed for the last 3 years. He requested the County Attorney convene a grand jury to investigate water quality due to the Army Corps of Engineers, illegal dumping of chromium at McGraw-Edison and the county. No action was taken.

Demry moved to approve the hiring of Nathan Johnson as part-time Transport Officer at \$23.40 per hour starting 7/1/17. Seconded by Waits. All voted aye.

Demry moved to approve Cynthia Bartels as Deputy Treasurer. Seconded by Waits. All voted aye.

Demry moved to approve K.C.'s Landing LLC liquor license. Seconded by Waits. All voted aye.

Demry moved to approve voiding Treasurer's check #6885 for \$27.00 and check #6958 for \$8.00, their correct totals. Seconded by Waits. All voted aye.

Matt Haden, County Engineer, stated Secondary Roads has been busy replacing 3 bridges with railroad tanker cars. The Brockus Bridge on 550<sup>th</sup> will close today and hopefully be opened next week. They will work on the Zugg Bridge next making 7 bridges in total this year. The brush cutter is still down. Waits stated he had concerns with brush covering signs on blind corners. Haden replied they need to get an arm mower and an aggressive spraying program. There was a recent resignation and will be looking to fill the position in the union.

Demry moved to open the public road vacation hearing. Seconded by Waits. All voted aye. Haden stated all adjoining land owners have signed the petition to vacate 169<sup>th</sup> Ave. starting 878 feet South of the South right-of-way line of 600<sup>th</sup> Street then heading South to the intersection of 610<sup>th</sup> Street; and 610<sup>th</sup> Street starting 2397 feet East of East right-of-way line of Highway 5 then heading East to the intersection of 169<sup>th</sup> Ave. Kids tear the road up mudding and gates will be put up on both ends. Along with the road vacation is a bridge that will be sold for \$1 each to the adjoining land owners. Waits moved to close the public hearing. Seconded by Demry. All voted aye. Demry moved to vacate 169<sup>th</sup> Ave. starting 878 feet South of the South right-of-way line of 600<sup>th</sup> Street then heading South to the intersection of 610<sup>th</sup> Street; and 610<sup>th</sup> Street starting 2397 feet East of East right-of-way line of Highway 5 then heading East to the intersection of 169<sup>th</sup> Ave. and to sell ½ of the bridge for \$1 to Ewing and ½ of the bridge for \$1 to Mullenix. Seconded by Waits. All voted aye.

Demry moved to approve payroll, prisoner room & board, Treasurer's semi-annual, and the Sheriff's, Recorder's, and Auditor's quarterly reports. Seconded by Waits. All voted aye.
