

August 21, 2017

Appanoose County Board of Supervisors met in regular session August 21, 2017 at 9:00 A.M. in the Boardroom of the Courthouse. Present: Mark Waits, Chairman, Neal Smith and Linda Demry, Boardmembers. Absent: None.

Smith moved to approve the agenda with the addition of public comments. Seconded by Demry. All voted aye.

Jason Fraser spoke on behalf of the Chariton Valley Regional Housing Trust Fund regarding their projects and funding request. Waits thanked them for reaching out to the small communities in Appanoose County.

Phil Brown from the Corps of Engineers spoke about the increase in visitation numbers based on an increase in revenue. Final visitation numbers will be released later in the year. The lake is at normal pool even with the dry conditions.

Demry moved to approve the minutes of the August 7, 2017 meeting. Seconded by Smith. All voted aye.

Susan Daniels was unable to attend the meeting to discuss the mental health region.

Alison Fraser from Morgan Cline Foundation discussed the health office clean-up cost. The Foundation is willing to pay half the costs. They felt there was not enough evidence presented to prove they were responsible for all the damage. Smith moved to approve accepting half the costs. Seconded by Demry. All voted aye. Fraser also stated the Foundation would be willing to help with the parking issues. Waits asked Fraser to coordinate with Kris Laursen.

Demry moved to approve The Spurs' liquor license. Seconded by Smith. All voted aye.

Smith moved to approve the temporary part-time hiring of Jessica Bratz, in the Assessor's Office starting 8/4/17 at \$10.00 per hour. Seconded by Demry. All voted aye.

Smith moved to approve the part-time hiring of Gwendolyn Kok, in the Recorder's Office effective 8/21/17 at \$12.00 per hour. Seconded by Waits. All voted aye.

FYI-Kris Laursen has been hired as Public Health Administrator, starting 9/1/17, with an annual salary of \$55,000 based on a 40 hour work week.

Demry stated she met with the Touring Commission, the Chamber is a member and the county will not receive any additional benefits. Demry moved to discontinue funding. Seconded by Smith. All voted aye.

Smith moved to set a public hearing for a Zoning Commission recommendation for 9/5/17 at 9:15 A.M. Seconded by Demry. All voted aye.

Matt Haden, County Engineer, stated there are 3 vacancies in the roads department looking to be filled. So far they have replaced 6 bridges this year. The Archer Bridge is still down and expected to be opened next month. They are looking into subcontracting spraying to help get a handle on the problem. Other projects include: ditching, parking areas, T20 pavement patching, and bridge deck repairs. No parking signs will be placed in Brazil due to parking congestion on the roadways thus allowing the Sheriff to ticket.

Demry moved to approve the payroll and prisoner room & board reports and Independence and Vermillion Township annual reports. Seconded by Smith. All voted aye.
