October 1, 2018

Appanoose County Board of Supervisors met in regular session October 1, 2018 at 9:00 A.M. in the Boardroom of the Courthouse. Present: Mark Waits, Chairman, Neal Smith and Linda Demry, Boardmembers. Absent: None.

Meeting started with the Pledge.

Smith motioned to approve the agenda. Seconded by Demry. All voted aye.

Demry motioned to approve the minutes of the September 17, 2018 meeting with the correction to the next governing board meeting as 9/27, not 10/27. Seconded by Smith. All voted aye.

Waits read an email dated 9/26/18 from Midwest Medical Transport's (MMT) Tim Hoffman. The email requests a \$20,000 per month subsidy until the City of Centerville's service takes over. Waits motioned to send a letter to all cities and MMT inviting them to a meeting to see about raising the funds for the subsidy. Seconded by Smith. All voted aye.

County Insurance bids were opened. Power Insurances' quote from Continental Western was \$162,425 and EMC was \$186,225. Hawk Insurance's quote from ICAP was \$157,084.73. A date of 10/8/18 at 9:00 A.M. was set to allow for presentations of the quotes.

Brian Moore from the Service Bureau presented the Board with photos from a road research project in Howard County and discussed a proposed project for Appanoose County. County Engineer Matt Haden, suggested the Forebush Road for the project. Testing is required first and the project would most likely start in the spring.

Haden presented a quote from Seneca for new fuel tanks at the county yard. They have had problems with the current tanks this last year not dispensing fuel and there could also be a leak. Haden stated he would be adding money in the October budget amendment so if testing comes back positive there is a leak the funds are available.

Demry motioned to approve \$250 to the Bluegrass Music Association. Seconded by Waits. All voted aye.

Tammy Cassady from Furever Friends requested the County start remitting the \$45 animal control fee to Furever Friends due to Heartland Humane Society no longer taking out of county animals. Demry motioned to continue paying \$45 per dog found in the unincorporated areas of Appanoose County to Forever Friends. Seconded by Smith. All voted aye.

Demry motioned to approve the Secondary Roads Quarterly Transfer. Seconded by Smith. All voted aye.

RESOLUTION #2018-25 FOR INTERFUND OPERATING TRANSFER

Whereas, it is desired to transfer monies from the Rural Services Fund to the Secondary Road Fund, and Whereas, said operating transfer is in accordance with section 331.432, Code of lowa, Now, therefore, be it resolved by the Board of Supervisors of Appanoose County, lowa as follows:

Section 1. The sum of \$ 155,652.50 is ordered to be transferred from the Rural Services Fund to the Secondary Road Fund, effective 10-01-2018.

Section 2. The Auditor is directed to correct her books accordingly and to notify the Treasurer of this operating transfer.

Smith motioned to accept the resignation of Jared Henkle from Secondary Roads effective 10/5/18. Seconded by Demry. All voted aye.

Haden mentioned forwarding 3 applications to the board for the GIS position after the deadline. The Tech 2 position is still open and he is advertising again. Henkle's position is going thru the bid process in the union. All 5 county built bridges are complete. The 2 Federal Aid Bridges will be complete following dirt work. The crews will now work on culverts and brush cutting.

CDS Coordinator, Stephanie Koch, was not present to give her report.

Smith motioned to approve payroll, Franklin, Johns, Lincoln & Udell Township financials. Seconded by Demry. All voted aye.

Public comments: Randall Raskie, Road Foreman asked if the Engineer position has been advertised. It has. Jason Fraser, City of Centerville Administrator, informed the board the \$20,000 subsidy for MMT would be closer to \$15,000 with the income surtax factored in. Richard Keilig Jr. stated Colton Mihalovich was a former student and will do a great job. He also asked for clarification on the income surtax. Midwest will receive approximately \$50,000 in income surtax funds which reduces the \$20,000 requested.

Demry motioned to adjourn. Seconded by Smith. All voted aye. The Board adjourned to meet at the call of the Auditor at 10:09 A.M.
