Stakeholders meet on the 9<sup>th</sup>. The office will be closed the 28<sup>th</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup> but someone will be checking messages. The next governing board meeting will be December 21<sup>st</sup> at 9:30 A.M. in Wapello County. The region is moving to a server system and her email will be changing to <a href="mailto:skoch@scbhr.net">skoch@scbhr.net</a>. Finally, she will be participating in a webinar on Ronda's House.

Public comments: Centerville City Administrator, Jason Fraser, said the city received bids to demo the old water plant. Golic requested the engineer check the roads when it rains not when it's dry.

Koch requested a closed session per lowa Code 21.5(1)(i). The board when into closed session at 9:39 A.M. Demry motioned to exit closed session at 9:53 A.M. Seconded by Smith. All voted aye. Demry motioned to approve Koch's employee evaluation. Seconded by Waits. All voted aye.
